

DIRECTIONS TO WHITE CROSS NEIGHBOURHOOD CENTRE LANCASTER, LA1 3SE

From Junction 34 of the M6 motorway (Caton Road)

Towards City Centre past The Holiday Inn on the right and Premier on left.

Past all the industrial estates/McDonalds etc and head to town.

Bare left onto Bulk Road.

Slight Left onto St Leonards gate (stone wall on your left)

Left onto Alfred Street and follow road until Moor Lane (a car park is opposite you if you need this)

Turn left and up the hill past the NHS offices then turn right onto St Peters Road. Past the Cathedral.

At the junction - go straight across Quarry Road to the White Cross Industrial Estate. White Cross Neighbourhood Centre is the first building – us!

You can head across and then round a mini roundabout and downwards towards the White Cross pub car park (if you are very lucky you may get a space there)

LCC staff only - staff car park with barrier access – on the Ind Estate then first right to arrive at our staff car park.

From Town Centre

Walking from Bus Station - walk up into the town and head left to find Dalton Square (The Queen Victoria Statue) then as below from Dalton Square

Driving from town centre- From Dalton Square (on the one way system through the city heading South) this is Thurnham St – head up Thurnham Street towards the Town Hall.

Turn left at the back of the Town Hall and this is George Street.

Head up George Street over the canal bridge, then turn right at the junction to the Industrial Estate but head to White Cross Neighbourhood Centre – first building. Driving - round a mini roundabout and downwards towards the White Cross pub car park.

Please note, there is no visitor parking on site. There is on-street metered parking on Quarry Road and a public car park on Nelson Street (footpath from the rear of the car park, which takes you along the canal bank to meet Quarry Road).
